



PROGRAM AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made between Progressive Pathways, known as “Program” and the undersigned (minor and guardian, or individual), “Student” constitutes a contract between Program and Student for skills training, likely to include, but not limited to, classroom and/or behind the wheel instruction of a motor vehicle under the Rules of the State of Minnesota. The Program partners with Streetwise Driving Academy, “School”, which is approved as a commercial driver education school, as well as a third-party knowledge test proctor by the State of Minnesota. Student pursuing driving education may be asked to sign a separate agreement with School. Outside of this Agreement, no verbal statements or promises will be recognized. Any changes to this Agreement must be amended in writing and attached hereto.

Program is providing Student with life skill training, specifically driver education, including the required 30 hours of classroom and 6 hours behind-the-wheel instruction (individual specification of needs outlined below, including cost and/or scholarship to Student). Program will offer supplemental information concerning community improvement, environmental issues, personal evolution and other such topics that follow the mission of the Program. It is not the intent of the Program to promote ideas that are of a political or religious nature.

The Mission: Progressive Pathways (Program) is committed to reducing the socioeconomic disparity gap affecting many families and urban youth in the Twin Cities by offering skills and opportunities to help lessen societal risks, while elevating young people into adulthood with environmentally conscious awareness in order to build stronger communities.

Program will provide supplemental information and activities in accordance with the Mission above. Student understands that they will learn about topics that coincide with said mission and, in exchange for scholarship earnings toward driving and other lessons,

Student agrees to:

1. Participate in at least 4 community volunteer opportunities (such as neighborhood clean-up, Elder visits, community feeds, mentoring, tutoring and any other activity that gives back and helps others);
2. Attend 3 additional classroom lessons that discuss the environmental effects of driving, alternative transportation options and carbon footprint reduction;
3. Use the opportunity to drive in a conscientious and responsible fashion – drive safely, share the roads with others (i.e. bicycles, scooters, pedestrians, etc.), remain drug and alcohol free while driving, and maintain higher level of driver awareness; and,
4. Follow the rules of the road and the laws of the State of Minnesota to become and remain a safe driver.

This agreement will also allow Program to provide Student with opportunities such as:

1. Driving time with a licensed driver toward the required 50 hours prior to Minnesota road test;
2. Credits toward alternative means of transportation such as electric vehicles, bicycles and bus cards;
3. Lower insurance rates;
4. Life skill training and mentorship;
5. Participation in community and group activities;
6. Guidance throughout the process of obtaining a valid license; and
7. Providing a ride to and a vehicle for the actual road test.
